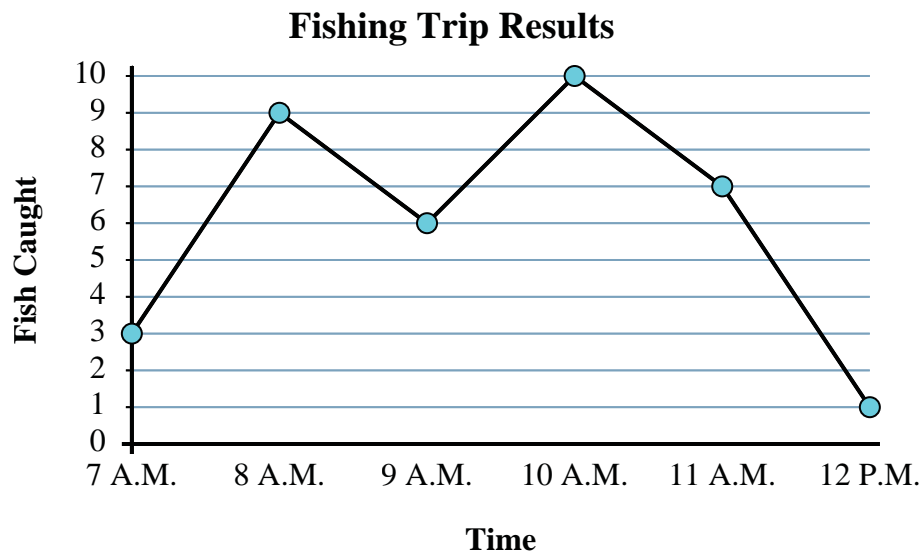




The graph below shows the number of fish caught in a day. Use the graph to answer the questions.



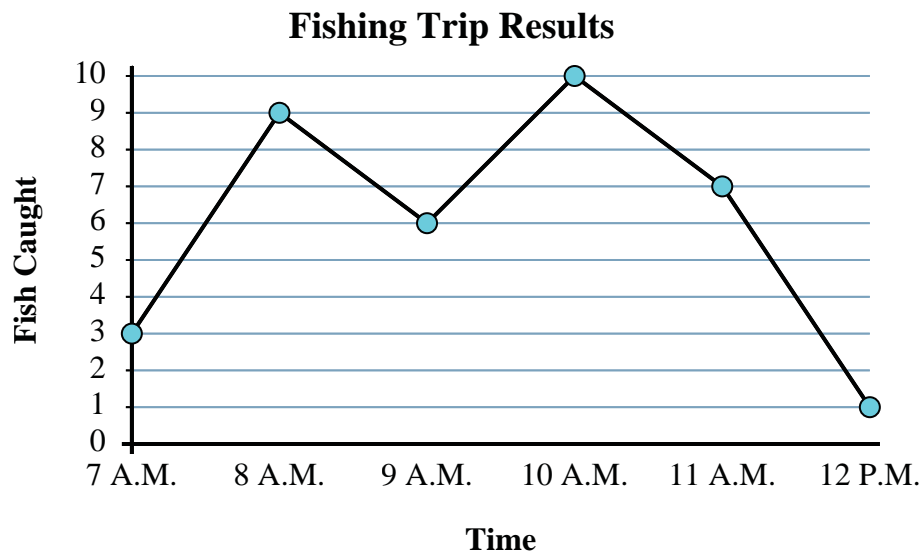
